The Festivals of Yahweh (Mark in Leviticus 23)

Date/ Event	Typical Significance	Reference
<u>First Month</u>		
14th - Lamb Killed 15th - Passover	Christ’s Sacrificial Death (1 Cor 5:7)	Exod 12:6; Lev 23:5
15th - Seven day Feast of Unleavened Bread	Memorials – Sincerity & Truth	Lev 23:6-8; Exod 12:15-20
18th - Firstfruits	Christ’s Resurrection (1 Cor 15:20,23)	Lev 23:10-14
<u>Third Month</u>		
8th - Pentecost	Gospel preached to Jew and Gentile (Acts 2:1,41)	Lev 23:16-21; Deut 16:10; Acts 2:1
Gleaning	Although this occurred mainly between Passover and Pentecost - It is placed here because it points to the time when Christ preached to both Jews and Gentiles scattered throughout the earth.	Lev 23:22
<u>Seventh Month</u>		
1st - Trumpets	Christ’s Return (1 Thes 4:16)	Lev 23:23-25
10th - Atonement	The Judgement Seat	Lev 23:26-32
15th - Feast of Tabernacles	Joyous Immortal Fellowship	Lev 23:33-43; Deut 16:13-15
