<b>THE FIRST ADVENT</b>	
1. He was a shepherd (Gen 37:2)	He is the Good Shepherd (Jn 10:11,14)
2. His name means "The Increaser"	John said of Jesus "He must increase" (Jn 3:30). "He shall see his seed" (Isa 53:10)
3. "Joseph brought unto his father their evil report" (Gen 37:2)	Jesus accused Israel's leaders of being "the children of them that killed the prophets. Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers" (Mat 23:31-32).
4. His "father loved him more than all his brethren" (Gen 37:4)	"This is my beloved son in whom I am well pleased" (Mat 3:17; also Col 1:13)
5. "His brethren said: 'Shalt thou indeed reign over us?'" (Gen 37:8)	"We will not have this man reign over us" (Lk 19:14). "We have no king but Caesar" (Jn 19:15).

Joseph	Jesus
6. "They hated him" (Gen.37:8)	"They hated me without a cause" (Jn 15:25)
7. "Because of his dreams" (Gen 37:8)	"When the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them" (Mat 21:45).
8. "I will send thee unto them" (i.e. thy brethren – Gen 37:13)	"He sent unto them His son" (Mat 21:37)
<b>BETRAYAL AND DEATH</b>	
1. "They conspired against him to slay him" (Gen 37:18)	"They consulted that they might take Jesus by subtlety" (Mat 26:4)
2. "Behold this dreamer" (Gen 37:19)	"They mocked him" (Mat 27:29)
3. "Let us slay him" (Gen 37:20)	"Let us kill him" (Mat 21:38)
4. "They stripped Joseph out of his coat" (Gen 37:23)	"For my vesture they did cast lots" (Jn 19:24)
5. "Cast him into a pit...lifted up out of the pit" (Gen 37:24,28)	"He brought me out of an horrible pit" (the grave – Psa 40:1-3). "He was not left in hell (the pit, or grave) neither did his flesh see corruption" (Acts 2:31)
6. "The pit was empty, there was no water in it" (Gen 37:24)	"..out of the pit (i.e. the grave) wherein is no water" (Zech 9:11)
7. "Judah said..."Come let us sell him"" (Gen 37:26, 27)	"Judas (Greek for Judah) communed how he might betray him" (Lk 22:4)
8. "Twenty pieces of silver" (Gen 37:28)	"Thirty pieces of silver" (Zech 11:12; Mat 27:3)
9. "They dipped (Joseph's) coat in blood" (Gen 37:31)	"He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood" (Rev 19:13) – a symbol representing the sacrifice of the Lord (Jn 19:34).
10. "This (blood-stained coat) have we found" (so deceiving Jacob – Gen 37:32)	"Say ye, his disciples came by night and stole him away while we slept" (to deceive the people - Mat 28:13)
11. Imprisoned in Egypt – rejected by his brethren, and now by the Gentile Potiphar (Gen 39, 40)	"He (Pilate) delivered him to be crucified" (Mat 27:26) – rejected by both Jew and Gentile.
12. Butler (restored) – Baker (executed) (Gen 40)	"Two thieves crucified with him" (Mat 27:38) – one forgiven.
<b>RESURRECTION</b>	
1. "At the end of two full years" (Gen 41:1) – i.e. in the third year.	"He rose again the third day" (1 Cor 15:4)
2. "Changed his raiment" (Gen 41:14)	"I will clothe thee with a change of raiment" (i.e. immortality) (Zech 3:4)
<b>ELEVATION</b>	
1. "Thou shalt be over my house" (Gen 41:38-40)	"Sit thou on my right hand" (Acts 2:34). "As a son over God's house" (Heb 3:6 – R.V.)
2. "Made him ruler" (Gen 41:43)	"All power is given me" (Mat 28:18)
3. "Joseph's brethren came and bowed down to him" (Gen 42:6)	"Ye (the Jews) shall not see me until ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord" (Mat 23:39).
<b>SECOND ADVENT – WHEN THE JEWS RECOGNISE JESUS AS THEIR MESSIAH</b>	
1. "His brethren knew him not" (Gen 42:8)	"One shall say, what are these wounds in thine hands?" (Zech 13:6). "Who is this king of glory?" (Psa 24:8)
2. "We are guilty; therefore is this distress come upon us" (Gen 42:21)	"Thou shalt call to mind (thy sins) among the nations whither Yahweh shall drive thee" (Deut 30:1)

3. "Joseph made himself known unto his brethren" (Gen 45:1)	"They shall look upon me whom they have pierced" (Zech 12:10)
4. "They were troubled at his presence" (Gen 45:3)	"And they shall mourn for him" (Zech 12:10)
5. "Be not grieved" (Gen 45:5)	"Comfort ye, comfort ye my people...that her iniquity is pardoned" (Isa 40:1-2; 61:3)
6. "God did send me before you to preserve life" (Gen 45:5)	"He shall appear the second time without sin unto salvation" (both national and individual - Heb 9:28)
7. "To preserve to you a posterity in the earth" (Gen 45:7)	"My servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and restore the preserved of Israel" (Isa 49:6)
8. "To save your lives by a great deliverance" (Gen 45:7)	"There shall come out of Zion the deliverer" (Rom 11:26)
9. "It was not you that sent me hither, but God" (Gen 45:8)	"The stone that the builders rejected: the same is become the head of the corner; this is the Lord's doing" (Mat 21:42)
<b>GENTILES UNDER CHRIST</b>	
"Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh" (Gen 47:20)	"The nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish" (Isa 60:12). "He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth" (Psa 72:8)
